Travel Ball Teams using the Batting Cage General Rules

- 1. Coaches have to be background checked. If already a SHDY or BabeRuth approved coach, no additional background check required. The cost of the background check must be paid by the travel team.
- 2. All players must fill out a current online SHDY or Babe Ruth player application, have birth certificate, and pay signup fee. If not a SHDY or Babe Ruth player, the player must pay the signup fee. The fee is nonrefundable. Application is good from January 1 to December 31 of each year. If the player is playing SHDY or Babe Ruth, no additional fees will apply for one season.
- 3. Must have proof of team insurance and submit a copy to the league to be kept on file. The insurance must have an added insurance rider listed for South Hill Dixie Youth and the Town of South Hill.
- 4. A copy of the team's player roster must be submitted to the league and kept current with player changes.
- 5. Each team will name a person responsible for cleanup, assuring the batting cage is locked, lights are off, heat is off, and all items put up. The persons contact information must be provided, preferably the team's manager.
- 6. Team will follow all current batting cage rules which are online and posted on the wall.
- 7. Travel team usage will be scheduled around SHDY and Babe Ruth scheduled practices. Mainly practice times will be available on Saturdays and Sundays.
- 8. If the above rules are not followed. The SHDY/Babe Ruth Board upon review of the problem it is having with the team not following rules, has the right to discontinue any team's usage of the batting cage.
