Joe Marshall

Joseph E. Marshall retired from the U.S. Postal Service and was a veteran of the U.S. Army and retired from the Alabama National Guard as a Chief Master Sergeant. He served as a DYB coach, league president and as the Alabama State Director, in which the field at Morningview School in Montgomery, Alabama is named in his honor.

Joe had a servant's heart and taught Sunday School for 50 years and was a member of the Capitol Heights United Methodist Church in Montgomery.

Mr. Marshall passed away on March 21, 2013 at the age of 89.

DYS was launched in 2024 and from Day 1 we wanted to provide the benefits of a scholarship program to the participants of our softball program. Unlike other organizations, only one year of participation is required to be eligible for one of our \$2,000 college scholarships. We realized that the number of girls that played in our inaugural season and were a graduating senior in 2025 could be small—and we had no way of knowing if we would receive any applications.
