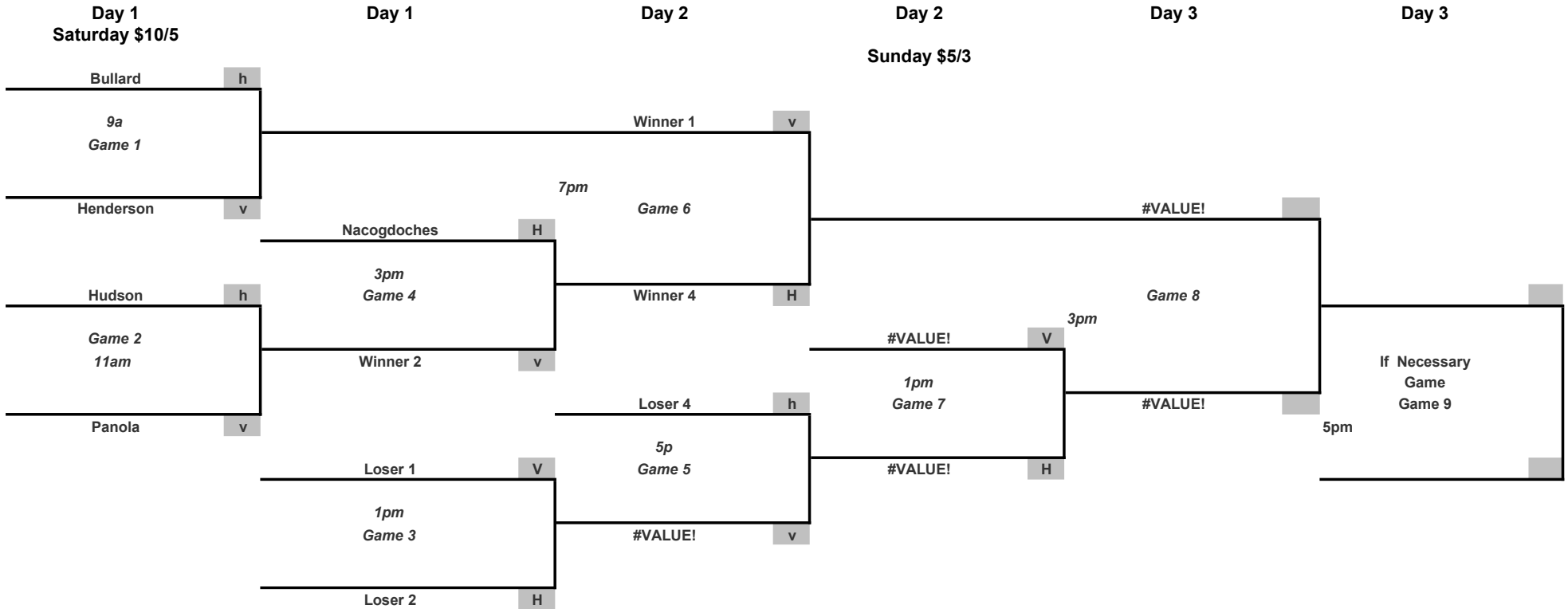




# Dixie Youth Baseball Modified Five Team Double Elimination Bracket

This modified 5-team bracket has been approved by the Commissioner of Dixie Youth Baseball only when all managers participating in this tournament bracket agree to use this bracket instead of the bracket published in the Dixie Youth Rule Book. We understand that in most instances, the Winner of Game 7 may play four games and use 24 innings of pitching and play against Team A, B or E which only used 12 innings of pitching in Game 8.

**We also understand Dixie Youth pitching rules will be followed without exception.**

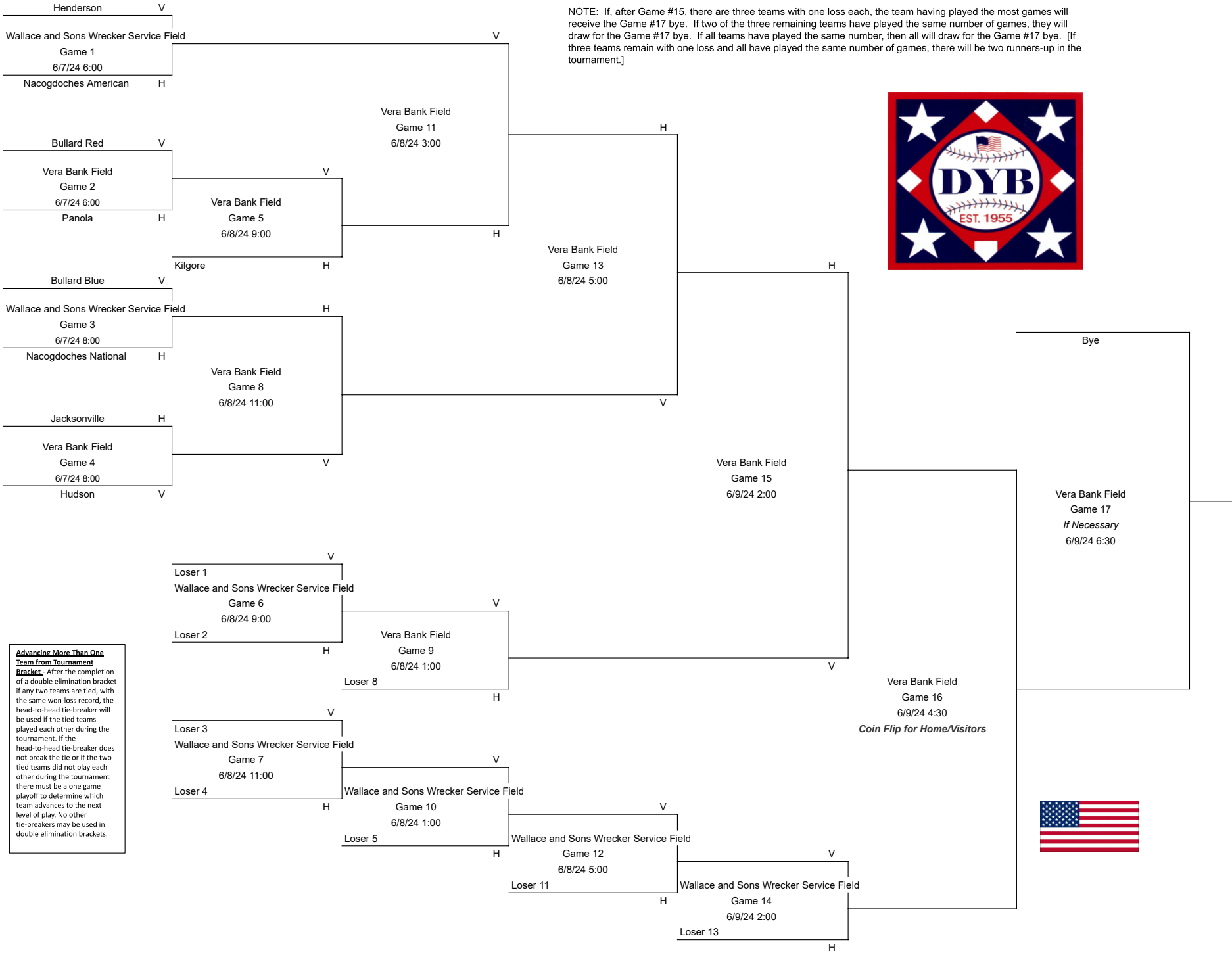

[If three teams remain with one loss and all have played the same number of games, there will be two runners-up in the tournament.]



**Advancing More Than One Team from Tournament Bracket:** After the completion of a double elimination bracket if any two teams are tied, with the same won-loss record, the head-to-head tie-breaker will be used if the tied teams played each other during the tournament. If the head-to-head tie-breaker does not break the tie or if the two tied teams did not play each other during the tournament there must be a one game playoff to determine which team advances to the next level of play. No other tie-breakers may be used in double elimination brackets.

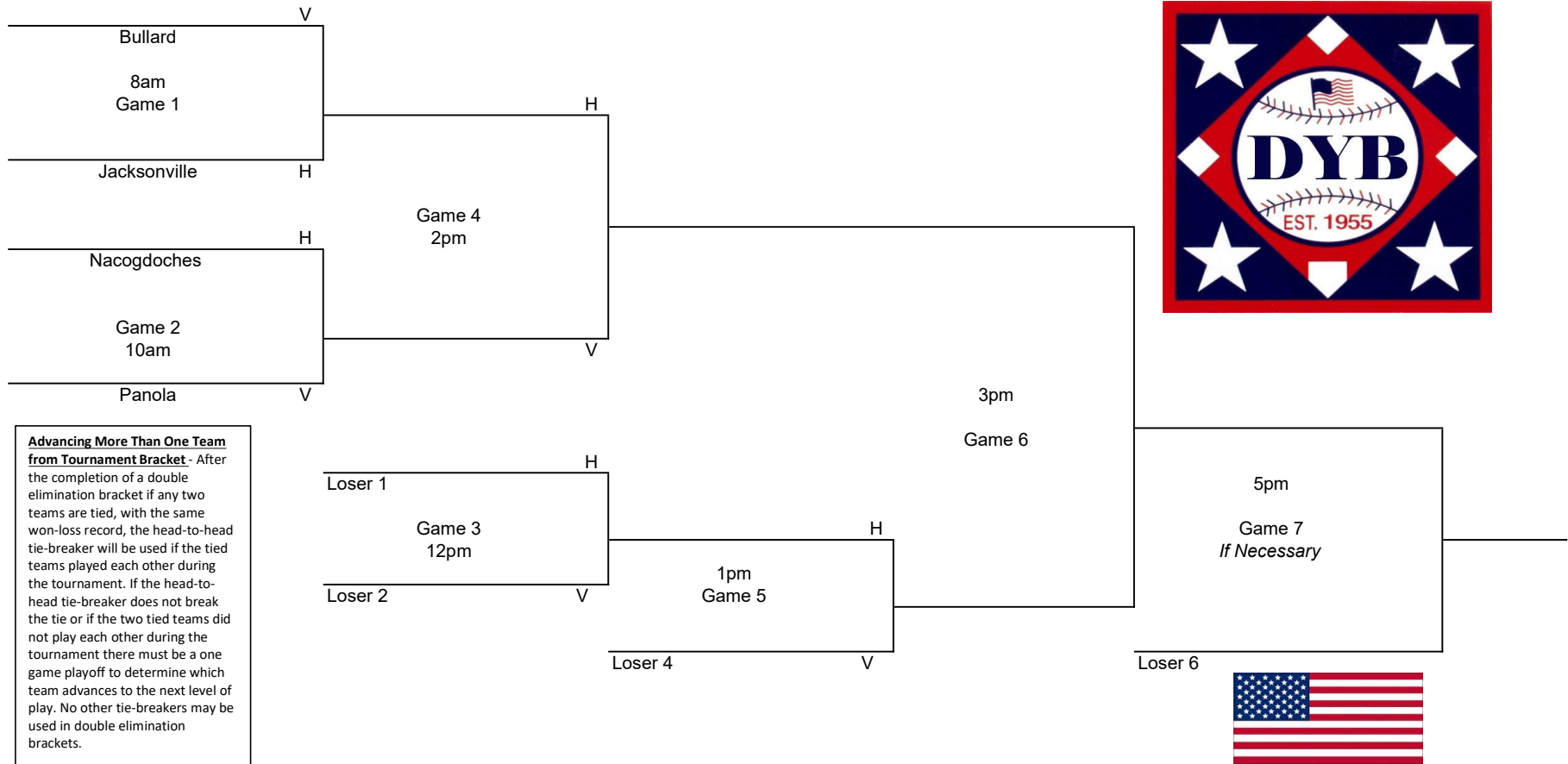

**Advancing More Than One Team from Tournament Bracket** - After the completion of a double elimination bracket if any two teams are tied, with the same won-loss record, the head-to-head tie-breaker will be used if the tied teams played each other during the tournament. If the head-to-head tie-breaker does not break the tie or if the two tied teams did not play each other during the tournament there must be a one game playoff to determine which team advances to the next level of play. No other tie-breakers may be used in double elimination brackets.

NOTE: If three (3) teams remain with one loss each after Game #3, a drawing will be held for the Game #5 Bye. The other two teams will play in Game #4. If only two teams remain after Game #3, they will play Game #4 and Game #5 if necessary.

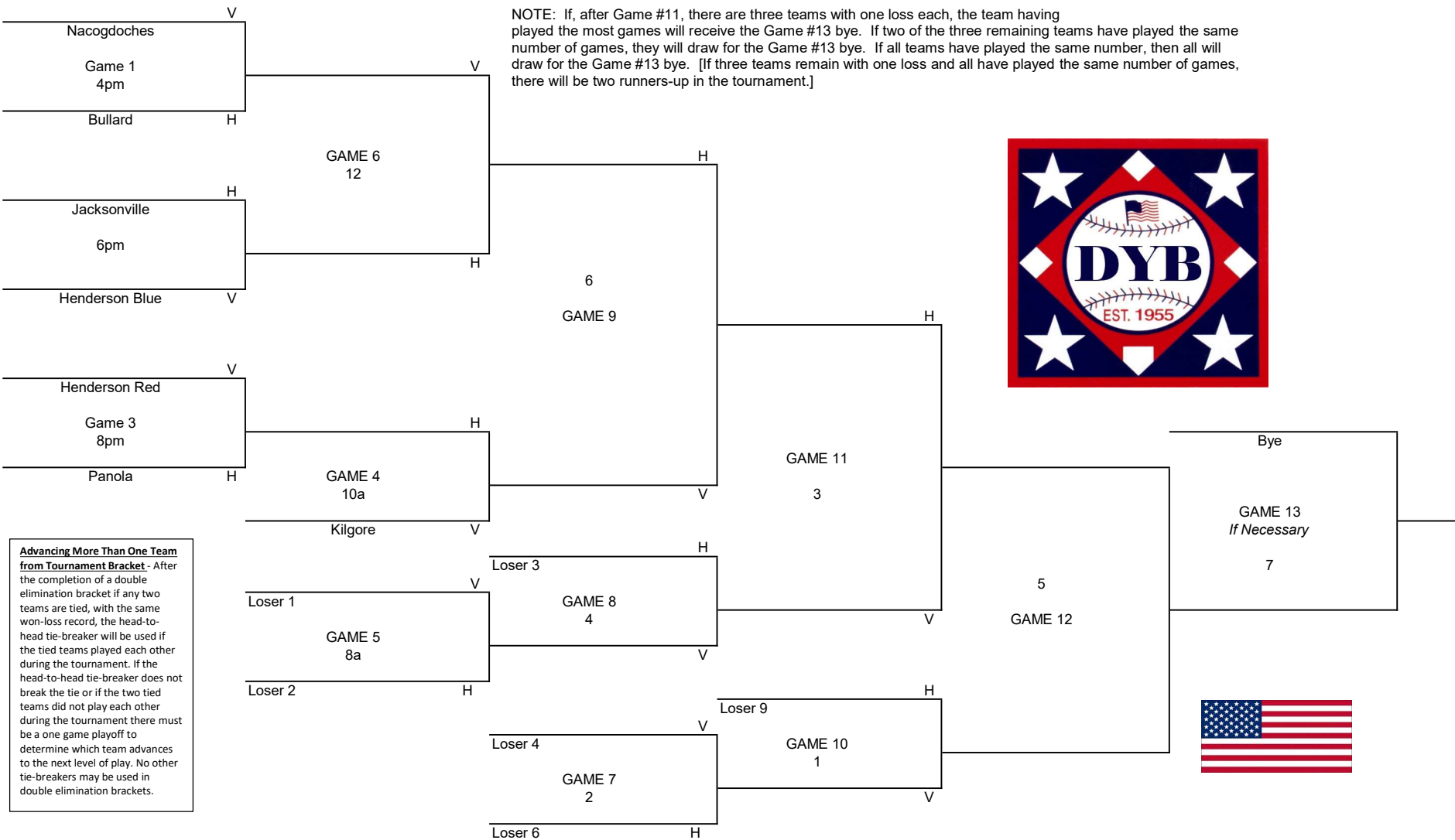
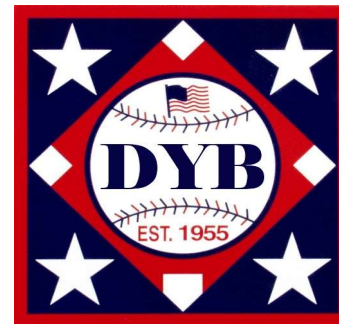
