



TEXAS SOFTBALL STATE CHAMPIONSHIP SERIES JULY 5-6, 2024 INFORMATION SHEET LEAR PARK

- **THERE IS A GATE CHARGE \$5 Adults - \$2 Children 5-12. Fans may ask for a wrist band if they leave the park on Saturday.**
- Players may bring **individual** ½ gallon thermos type coolers with water. **The host does not furnish water.** Teams may bring one ice chest with ice or ice **water (no bottled water, Gatorade, or other bottle or can drinks.** Teams may also bring a cooler with cooling rags.
- All Teams must have a minimum of 11 or maximum or maximum of 12.
- Teams must bring its credentials notebook with you to Coaches Meeting, 30 minutes prior to Friday's game.
- Teams turn in team affidavit to the scorekeeper on the field where you play.
- Teams turn in line-up 20 minutes prior to scheduled game time. Players **First and last names** with number and coaches first and last name should be on line-up cards. Games may start early when possible.
- Teams should wait until the announcer calls teams to go onto the field for infield warm up.
- Fields are easily identified with field numbers posted on them.
- Teams should ensure that two players are not wearing the same number. Players and coaches must have the DYB patch on the left sleeve of their uniform shirts.
- Players will be introduced and go onto the field as normally done before games.
- The state champions will receive a championship flag and rings. The runner-up teams will receive rings.
- **6U, 8U, AND 12U Division teams** will bat the line-up.
- **15U** teams will have a 9-player lineup.
- All players on 6U, 8U, 10U and 12U teams must play six (6) defensive outs. Teams shall report defensive changes to the scorekeeper. See Rule 6.02 for penalty.
- Home and Visitor for the first game of the Series will be flipped at the Coaches Meeting. The Visitor team in Game 1 will be the Home team in Game 2. If there is a Game 3 in the Series, there will be a coin flip to designate Home and Visitor.
