This page presents the expectations for conduct from athletes, parents and coaches that are part of the Sabine Little League Football and Cheer (SLLFC). Enforcing this Code of Conduct allows SLLFC to promote a safe, rewarding, and fun experience for our entire community.

Please read this information carefully. Each participant and Parents are required to acknowledge the Code of Conduct before the season begins and must abide by the Code of Conduct throughout the entire season.

Violations of the Code of Conduct may result in a disciplinary action including suspension – either temporarily or permanently as determined by the SLLFC Board.

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR PLAYERS

As a player...

- I will be a good sport to players, coaches, officials, opponents, and parents for every game and practice, no matter win or lose.
 - I will learn the value of commitment by making every reasonable effort to attend all practices and games, and I will notify my coach if I cannot attend a practice or game.
 - I will encourage my parents to be involved with my team in some capacity because it is important to me.
 - I will refrain from using foul or offensive language.
 - I will encourage my teammates and praise good efforts.
 - I will be honest, fair, and respectful to others at all times.
 - I will aim to learn all I can from sports.
 - I will show up dressed in correct attire for games and practices.
 - I will arrive at practice on time and be ready to dedicate my attention to my coaches.
 - I understand that I represent the Sabine Little League Football and Cheer at school and after school activities.
 - I will not belittle, bully, or ridicule the league (SLLFC) or anyone involved in the youth program or youth sporting event in public, private, in-person or online.
 - *Football* If I have an unsportsmanlike event, it will result in my immediate removal from the game or practice and a loss of playing time.
 - *Football* If I have an unsportsmanlike event that is the result of a poor interaction with an official, it will result in my removal from a game and a one-game suspension.
 - *Football* Repeated or severe 1st time unsportsmanlike violations will result in expulsion from league (SLLFC)

As a parent or guardian...

- I will put the emotional and physical well-being of youth participants ahead of personal desire to win.
 - I will respect players, coaches, officials, spectators, and families at all times.
 - I will respect the decisions of officials or coaches
 - I will not engage in any violence or verbal threats or use any profanity.
 - I will model good sportsmanship for all youth participants.
 - I will not belittle or ridicule the League (SLLFC) or anyone involved in a youth sporting event – in public, private, in person, or online.
 - I will refrain from using foul or offensive language.
 - I will do my part to keep sports fun and positive for every youth participant.
 - I will abstain from being under the influence of or in possession of alcoholic beverages and the possession or use of illegal substance on both game and practice fields.
 - I will be responsible for any actions and conduct of any guests that I may bring to an SLLFC event.
 - I will direct constructive criticism of my child's team's program to the head coach and/or SLLFC Board members at an appropriate time. I will work towards a positive result for all concerned.
