On what date will the first game be played? _____ What is the minimum number of games scheduled for each team this season? _____ "As a mandatory requirement to affiliate with DYB, Inc. ("DYB"), our Diamond Youth Softball ("DYS") league certifies it will comply with all of the following:

- (1) Our League will comply with all DYS franchise requirements, including but not limited to, DYS boundary requirements, local league and tournament playing rules, DYS policies and regulations outlined in the current edition of the Official Diamond Youth Softball Rules and Regulations.
- (2) Our league will comply with Federal Public Law 115-126 – Protecting Young Victims from Sexual Abuse and Safe Sport Authorization Act of 2017 ("Safe Sport Act") by formally adopting and implementing the DYS Child Protection Plan (a child abuse/molestation risk management plan) or a similar comprehensive plan. Our league will distribute the League's risk management plan to each authorized adult participant who is in regular contact with amateur athletes. Our league is in compliance with applicable federal, state and local laws including COVID-19 guidelines.
- (3) Our league will conduct third-party criminal background checks which, at a minimum, search the National Criminal Database and the National Sex Offender Registry in all 50 states and maintain documentation of the successful passing for all managers, coaches and other authorized adult participants in the league who have repetitive access to and close contact with minor athletes.

Note: Each League must certify to DYS that all managers and coaches on its all-star softball teams which participate in tournament play (including sub-district, district, and state tournaments and the DYS World Series) have successfully passed a criminal background check.
